# REPORT OF ANNUAL ACTIVITY: January - December 2007

# 1 - STATEMENTS FOR THE ACTIVITY OF THE PC

The activities of this PC are planned and executed in order to promote the republishing of classical works of reference, to promote the collection and circulation of material and information in the field of MMS, to maintain the Archive of the Federation, and to promote activities and works in the field of the history of MMS.

# 2 - MEMBERS

The number of individual members currently sums up to 60 from 32 different IFToMM member countries all over the world; 48 of the individual members are full members (maximal 2 from each IFToMM member country); the remaining 12 individual members are observers.

# 3 - CHANGE OF CHAIR

The new chairman of the PC, Dr. Hanfried Kerle from Braunschweig (Germany), was nominated by the present PC members and confirmed by the IFToMM Executive Council on the occasion of the 12<sup>th</sup> IFToMM World Congress in Besançon (France), June 2007. Dr. Kerle follows Prof. Hong-Sen Yan from Tainan (Taiwan, ROC).

#### 4 - HMMS PUBLICATIONS

On the occasion of the 12<sup>th</sup> IFToMM World Congress in Besançon (France), June 2007, three HMMS books were presented published by the Springer Company:
