1 - STATEMENTS FOR THE ACTIVITIES OF THE PC

3 - HMMS SYMPOSIUM



The last (3rd) International Symposium on HMMS (HMM 2008) was held on November 11-14, 2008 at National Cheng Kung University (NCKU) in Tainan (Taiwan). Chairman of the Organizing Committee was Prof. Hong-Sen Yan from NCKU. The symposium started with a special panel discussion in the NCKU museum concerning mechanism model collections all over the world. The symposium proceedings containing all the 26 papers presented can **now** be found in a bound volume (eds.: Hong-Sen Yan and Marco Ceccarelli) published by Springer Co. in 2009 (more on http://www.springer.com/978-1-4020-9484-2). It is part (Vol. 4) of the new Springer series on HMMS, cf. Item No. 6.
